

INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR FORM/AGREEMENT FOR OFFICIATING SERVICES

This agreement is made and entered into on this _____ day of _____, 2019, by and between the Northern California Women's Lacrosse Umpires Association (NCWLUA), hereinafter referred to as (NCWLUA) and _____ hereinafter referred to as (Official). This contract becomes effective January 1, 2019, and expires on December 31, 2019.

1. NCWLUA agrees to train, evaluate and assign individual Officials, provide written materials, conduct regular meetings, field trainings, and rating opportunities. NCWLUA agrees to make assignments based upon the NCWLUA needs and past ratings of Officials, of which the Officials may accept or decline.
2. NCWLUA shall not guarantee any game assignments to any Officials.
3. Official agrees to attend classroom trainings, field training, and to meet all NCWLUA, CIF, and USL requirements.
4. Official agrees to meet all of USL service time based on their level of rating. (Apprentice, Local, District, National).
5. Officials agree to be members of USL, NCWLUA, abide by current NCWLUA BYLAWS, and meet all requirements and to be member in good standing.
6. Official shall acquire, maintain at his/her own cost and expense, such equipment as Official needs for his/her daily performance of officiating services, including, but not limited to, an approved uniform, which shall always be maintained and worn in a clean, pressed and professional manner.
7. NCWLUA is not required to provide health nor Liability Insurance for Official.
8. It is understood that Official is an independent contractor and not an employee or agent of NCWLUA.
9. Officials shall be members of USL. US Lacrosse Member Officials have insurance coverage provided by Bollinger Insurance. For more information go to <http://www.uslacrosse.org/membership/insurance/general-information.aspx>.
10. Official shall indemnify and hold harmless the NCWLUA and its Officers. Official is solely responsible for Official's actions in route to and from, and while at, all assignment sites.
11. The individual character of the Official is an important factor in officiating. The Official warrants that by executing of this contract that there is nothing in their individual backgrounds that would call into question such qualifications. Specifically, official states that he/she has never been convicted of a felony or crime of moral turpitude, especially with children. Breach of this is grounds for discharge.
12. The Official recognizes the physical rigors of officiating and will be examined by his/her physician or opts not to by his/her choice. This decision is a conscious choice by the Official and the Official thus agrees to waive any and all legal rights in the future against the Assignor and NCWLUA for officiating activities.
